These include, but are not limited to the following:



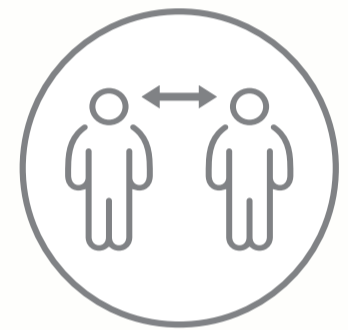
Staff temperature will be taken on a daily basis. Those displaying symptoms will be excluded from the workplace.



Employee hours have been adjusted to travel safely outside of peak hours on public transport.



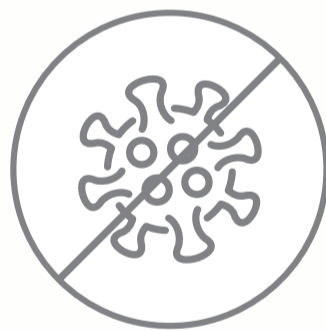
All employees have been trained in the regularity & technique of hand washing.



Reduced number of employees in a given shift adhering to social distancing.



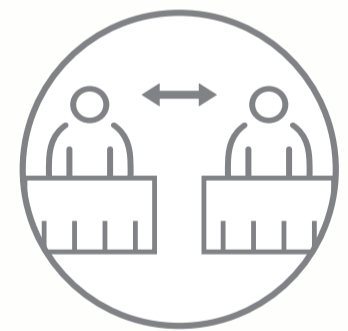
Face coverings will be worn by all staff members when attending to guests and PPE is available on site.



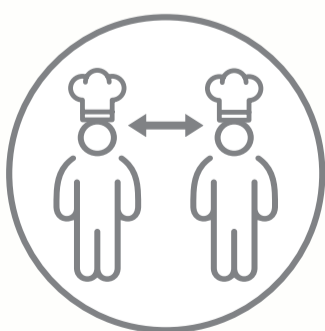
Guests who are showing symptoms of Covid-19 will not be permitted into the premises.
